### **Pancon Connectors and decaBDE: RoHS Directive 2002/95/EC**

As of 1 July 2008 the European Union has banned DecaBDE flame retardant in electronic and electrical equipment. The maximum sum of polybrominated diphenyl ethers (including decaBDE) must be less than 0,1%.


The European Union had already banned the use of DecaBDE as a flame retardant in electronics and electrical equipment two years ago. Directive 2002/95/EC on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (known as the RoHS Directive) had provided for this. This ban was lifted due to objections from the EU parliament and Denmark. The European Court of Justice (ECJ) now decided the case and the ban of the substance will come into force as of July 1/2008.

We as Pancon GmbH have contacted our base material suppliers and received their corresponding statements of compliance.

Therefore we hereby declare that our products do not contain decaBDE in concentrations above the limits provided for in the directive.
